Membership Benefits and Policy

Membership of the Mosque carries a range of privileges, responsibilities, and opportunities designed to strengthen community participation, spiritual growth, and good governance. The following benefits apply to all formal members in good standing:

1. Governance and Representation

- 1.1. Members possess full voting rights at Annual General Meetings (AGMs), including the right to elect committee members and participate in key decisions affecting the mosque's operations and future direction.
- 1.2. Only members are eligible to be nominated for positions within the Shura, Management, or Executive Committees.

2. Access to Mosque Services

- 2.1. Members are entitled to preferential access to all mosque services, including nikkah (marriage) ceremonies, funeral arrangements, madrassah admissions, and counseling sessions.
- 2.2. Members receive a 50% discount on the hire of the community hall for personal events.
- 2.3. In the event of a bereavement, the community hall will be provided free of charge for the Fatiha (fourth-day prayer gathering).

3. Religious and Spiritual Support

- 3.1. Members may seek guidance from imams and scholars on matters of faith and personal conduct.
- 3.2. Members are encouraged to participate in congregational prayers, study circles, and spiritual development programs.
- 3.3. Family and life services, including newborn (Tahneek) ceremonies, marriage counseling, and mediation, are available to members.

4. Education and Youth Development

- 4.1. Children of members may be granted priority admission to the madrassah.
- 4.2. Members are encouraged to participate in educational programs, youth initiatives, and lifelong learning opportunities organized by the mosque.

5. Community Engagement

- 5.1. Members have access to various social, cultural, and volunteering programs that promote unity, charity, and civic responsibility.
- 5.2. Members receive invitations to participate in the mosque's outreach and community service initiatives.

6. Financial and Administrative Transparency

- 6.1. Members are entitled to attend the AGM, during which the Management Committee presents annual reports on mosque activities, finances, and strategic plans.
- 6.2. Membership fees contribute directly to the maintenance, staffing, utilities, and development of the mosque's facilities and services.

7. Additional Benefits

- 7.1. Members may be eligible to join the Funeral Assurance Committee (subject to applicable terms and conditions).
- 7.2. Assistance is available for documentation and administrative services, including attestation, NADRA ID facilitation, and signposting to relevant government agencies.
- 7.3. Members receive periodic newsletters and communications providing updates on mosque projects, events, and community initiatives.
- 7.4. Membership fees are treated as Lillah contributions and may be eligible for tax deduction, with annual receipts issued accordingly.

8. Membership Fees and Renewal

- 8.1. Membership is open to individuals aged 18 years and over who align with the aims and objectives of the Mosque.
- 8.2. The membership fee is set at £10 per month for adult members (aged 18 and above).
- 8.3. Membership is free of charge for O.A.Ps (Old Age Pensioners) as a gesture of respect and appreciation for their lifelong contributions to the community.
- 8.4. Membership must be renewed annually to maintain eligibility for benefits, voting rights, and participation in mosque governance.
- 8.5. All membership fees are treated as Lillah contributions, directly supporting the upkeep, maintenance, and operation of the Mosque and its community programs.
- 8.6. Members are encouraged to maintain active engagement and good standing throughout their membership period.

9. Membership Eligibility and Termination

- 9.1. Membership is open to any individual who:
- a) Follows the teachings of Sunni Islam, and
- b) Believes in the finality of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) as the last and final messenger of Allah.
- 9.2. Members must conduct themselves in a manner consistent with Islamic ethics, respect the rules and constitution of the Mosque, and uphold the unity and integrity of the Muslim community.
- 9.3. Membership may be suspended or terminated by the Management Committee under the following circumstances:
- a) Failure to pay membership fees for a continuous period exceeding three months without valid
- b) Conduct deemed contrary to the objectives, values, or reputation of the Mosque;

- c) Violation of the Mosque's constitution or code of conduct; or
- d) Written resignation submitted by the member.
- 9.4. Any termination of membership shall be decided by the Management Committee following due process, with the member afforded an opportunity to provide an explanation before a final decision is made.
- 9.5. Reinstatement of membership may be considered upon written application, subject to committee approval.
